



<p>The MCR Pathway has been expanded across 6 schools Due to lockdown, commencement of the programme was significantly delayed. Young people are being identified to be part of the programme including the group activities and mentoring.</p> <p>Group 1 includes those who are both currently and previously Looked After Group 2 includes Young Carers, those in Informal Kinship and those who are in need of additional support</p>	<p>Pupils engaged with the MCR Pathways co-ordinator and were increasingly able to talk positively about their school experiences.</p> <p>The cohort of S1 pupils have increased their attendance by 20% and decreased their exclusions by 10%.</p> <p>S2 pupils have increased their attendance by 37.5% and decreased their exclusions by 12.5%.</p>
