15 Stretch Outcomes

ECONOMY

1. No one will suffer due to poverty
2. Supporting 400 unemployed people into fair work
3. Upskilling and reskilling 500 people to take advantage of economic opportunities

PEOPLE

4. 95% of children 0-5 years reaching their expected developmental milestones
5. Mental health - 90% of children and young people feel listened to
6. Care experienced young people doing as well as their peers
7. Positive destinations for children in most deprived communities
8. Positive destinations for children with additional support needs
9. 30% fewer young people charged
10. Community justice – fewer convictions and reconvictions
11. Health life expectancy is five years longer
12. Drug related deaths lower than Scotland and 4% reduction in harmful levels of drinking

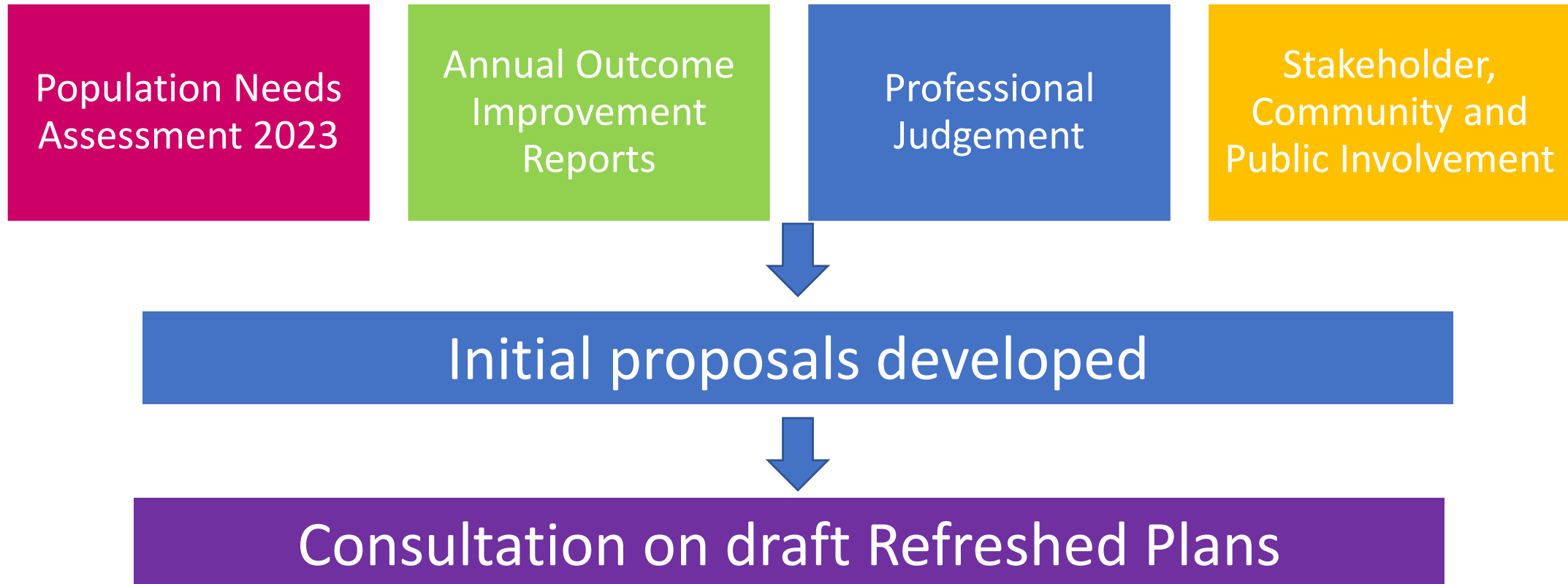

Headline Changes Proposed



- 16 Stretch Outcomes – of which two are:
 - Reduce overall homeless presentations by 10% and youth homelessness by 6% by 2026 and
 - “50% of citizens report they feel able to participate in decisions that help change things for the better by 2026.” - incorporated from the Community Empowerment Strategy
- As well as the two additions,
 - 7 Stretch Outcomes have been **refreshed** and
 - 7 remain the **same** and
 - Current Stretch Outcome 3 “500 Aberdeen City residents upskilled/ reskilled to enable them to move into, within and between economic opportunities as they arise by 2026” has been **achieved** and proposed to be **removed** with improvement activity in relation to upskilling/reskilling to come under refreshed Stretch Outcome 2 “Working towards a 74% employment rate for Aberdeen City by 2026”
- **95 improvement aims** proposed to support achievement of our Stretch Outcomes, an increase 21 compared with the current LOIP.
