5	Project Updates (new initiatives)	JL (Community Development Manager) Police Scotland - Derek Bain has officially left post but will be retaining pieces of work with the Hub. Update to follow when replacement is in post. Fire and rescue service - happy to come if issues are relevant, do not have capacity for routinely attendance at pnps as staff numbers are low. JF (Community Rep) The Woodside Gateway Feature was part of an initiative instigated by Sustrans around 6 years ago. The whole project was to improve the roads/pedestrian experiences in and around Tillydrone. The Tillydrone Gateway Feature (the 'Swans' sculpture at Diamond Bridge) was born out of the same initiative. For the Woodside Gateway Feature, Hamish Biggs did consultations with local schools and then presented his ideas to the community (in St George's Church), so that one could be selected. This was summer 2018. Cruyff Court Tillydrone – 13th of May opening DB (SHMU)		

		Dave gave a brief update, on behalf of the Woodside Network, of the Woodside Decides project. The project has so far involved engaging community members to understand better the priorities of people in Woodside. The next stage, includes an event on Wednesday March 20th at 6.45pm (Fersands Community Centre) is a community commissioning exercise where community members discuss priorities and allocate £8,000 in relation to environmental and mental health and wellbeing policies.
