7. Torry 10K Still at the update stage. 13th of May, huge success. Manageable 100/150 participants. Volunteers stationed at different routes. Parts of the coastal route that were eroded. Learning on planning route. June 15th event. Potentially Aug, September for a marathon/ event for summer. Work in collab to promote but do community collab for the event. Torry 10k NOT coastal. 8. RACC No housing officer present to give an update (Locality Planning team received communication before the meeting) council officers have been asked several times to attend. Progress very slow. In a few months' time there will be different option provided to local people who are affected by RACC. (Who will come in front of us at full Council for us to take a decision?) Support services available. Search results on the Council website which are regularly updated. Click on Related content – local services. British Red Cross has a crisis line available, online or in person emotional support. BRC also provides packing residents homes, however no transport for relocation. CC meeting - it was discussed about the effect this will have for doctors / schools / local businesses. What financial effect will this have?
