3. Partner updates Paul Webb SFRS – Fire and Rescue have been looking at ways to interact with communities, 5 watches at each station that have a risk reduction area. Shmu and other community led organisations are supporting the fire and rescue service to grow exposure over the coming months/year. An operational plan for the City of Aberdeen, Social media safety posts Partnership presentations to schools, Media campaign and press release, All SFRS bonfire/firework safety literature, presentations, YouTube videos will be shared with schools. Foodbanks have been working closely with F&R service, they provide home fire safety requests within the bags on distribution. F&R service involvement with future PNPS to be discussed. City Centre fire deaths have increased – 6 deaths in total. F&S rescue want to do engagements on basic fire safety advice in council locations at council meetings with staff and public - if possible in the near future. Stuart Stevenson PS – No stat updates. Police Scotland have recently been making in person visits to nurseries, schools and old folks homes to input re online safety. E Bikes have been identified as a larger scale issue at the moment over the City. Police Scotland looking for radio input on safety advice. Possible links with the Fire Safety service and Dave Black (Shmu) SAMH – 3 sessions booked in for suicide prevention in September, October and November OCT NOV SAMH will provide the posters and any other promotional materials.
