SO2	Claimant Count	16/11/2025	→	In October 2025 there were 5,190 claimants in Aberdeen City, up from 5,170 in September.	
SO2	Priority IZ Claimants	16/11/2025	→	In October 2025 there were 2,415 claimants in priority IZs, up from 2,355 in September.	
SO1	Universal credit	16/11/2025	↓	In October 2025 there were 24,364 people on Universal Credit – up from 23,881 in September.	
SO13	Household waste	16/11/2025	→	In 2024, 89,333 tonnes of household waste were generated – similar to 2023 when 89,314 tonnes were generated.	
SO14	Walking and cycling as main mode of travel	02/12/2025	→	In 2024, an estimated 25% of people walked as their main mode of travel – down from 30% in 2023. An estimated 1% used a bicycle as their main mode of travel – the same as in 2023.	

SO14	Active travel to work	02/12/2025	→	In 2024, an estimated 14% of people used active travel (walk or bicycle) to get to work – slightly up from 13% in 2023 and similar to the rate for Scotland of 14.2%.	
SO10	Estimated Life Expectancy at Birth	10/12/2025	→	In 2022-2024, estimated life expectancy at birth for females was 81.3 years – up slightly from 80.9 years in 2021-2023 and slightly higher than the figure for Scotland of 81.1 years. In 2022-2024, estimated life expectancy at birth for males was 77.3 years for males – up slightly from 76.9 years in 2021-2023 and slightly higher than the figures for Scotland of 77.1 years.
