Development of the Local Outcome Improvement Plans 2026-36, Locality Plans 2026-36 and Children's Services Plan: Community Planning Aberdeen's Outcome Improvement Groups and Locality Empowerment Groups and Priority Neighbourhood Partnerships are using the outcome of the engagement to inform and develop the Plans. Further engagement with communities to co-create solutions and develop the plans will be help over the coming months. We'll also consult on the draft Plans in early 2026.

- Local Housing Strategy (approved by the Communities, Housing and Public Protection Committee on 26 August 2025) *The refreshed Local Housing Strategy (LHS) focuses on providing the people of Aberdeen good quality, safe, sustainable and affordable homes in thriving communities over the period 2025-2030. The LHS now has much more of a person-centred focus and considers the impact of housing on the people of Aberdeen through our exploration of the [social determinants of health](#). In addition, consideration of personas, based on our citizens with complex housing and support needs, have helped ensure that the new LHS takes account of those who need our help most. This significant change in approach represents a shift in primary focus from buildings to people. It also serves to remind us of why we are here, and who it is that we support. All feedback from stakeholders in relation to the LHS gathered during the “Your Place, Your Plans, Your Future” engagement exercise was collated into a “You Said, We Did” format, which outlines exactly how the comments and suggestions were used to improve the strategy and its accompanying Delivery Plan. The Delivery Plan sets out a list of targets and actions which will help to achieve the overall vision of the LHS between 2025-30, with the plan being continually reviewed over the lifespan of the LHS to ensure that progress is being made and opportunities for improvement are identified*
